

This is to define the requirements and admission procedures for Membership in the NBMA by members of other New Brunswick massage therapy associations

## Requirements

1. To be eligible for admission to membership in the NBMA under this policy, the applicant must be an active member in good standing in another massage therapy association in New Brunswick recognised by the NBMA.
2. Actually, the only other association recognised by NBMA is the Association of New Brunswick Massage Therapists, ANBMT.

## Procedures

3. The applicant must provide proof of membership in a form acceptable to the Registrar of NBMA.
4. The applicant will be required to complete and sign a declaration containing the wording below:

I \_\_\_\_\_ hereby attest that I am an Active member in good standing with the \_\_\_\_\_ and have had continuous membership since \_\_\_\_\_. I have never conducted myself in a manner which would be prejudicial to my continuance as a member of that association. I am dedicated to the high principles of the profession of massage therapy and I believe that I would be a valuable asset to the New Brunswick Massotherapy Association.

5. The applicant shall complete such other documents and declarations as may be required by the Registrar and shall pay the appropriate fees
6. The applicant shall not be required to take the Oral and Practical Admission Examination administered by the NBMA Standards and Examinations Committee.
7. The applicant may retain membership in the other association.
8. The applicant shall upgrade liability insurance coverage to the NBMA standard when the applicant's present coverage runs out.
