



PART III - POSSIBLE SCENARIO

Here is an example of a possible scenario for demonstration by the applicant:

Your client is a 45 year old male construction worker who had a lifting injury 3 weeks ago. His physician referred him to a physiotherapist whom he has seen daily since the injury.

He expresses frustration with how slowly the injury is healing and has come to you on the recommendation of a friend. He has a muscular build and does not display an antalgic gait or any sign of muscle weakness.

Example of possible questions :

Demonstrate sternocleidomastoid

Demonstrate rhomboids (Major or Minor)

Demonstrate occipital bone, L5, C7

Q. What changes, if any, would you make if the client were a 26 week pregnant woman?

Q. What changes, if any, would you make if client presents with flushed face, dry lips, glassy eyes, skin hot and dry to touch, complaining of general malaise and feeling cold?
